CONDUCT ON BOARD A SHIP

A merchant vessel is a workplace and bears many potential dangers.

Therefore, please observe the following rules of conduct when on board:

- Only board a vessel if accompanied by an authorized person
- All instructions must be strictly adhered to
- Always inform gangway watchman of your presence on board
- Use only safe and secure passages and gangways
- Always ensure that you have firm footing, do not run and make sure that you also wear appropriate footwear
- Always wear a helmet and a warning jacket
- Observe all cautionary notices and signs
- Ensure that all your movements are outside of any danger zones, i.e.:
 - o Never stop or move under suspended heavy loads
 - o Only ever enter engine rooms, hatches, etc. after receiving permission or of accompanied by an authorized person.

All other matters will be dealt with by the UVV-See or other local safety regulations.
